



Bangs ISD Dual Credit Parent/Student Agreement

GENERAL INFORMATION

Bangs Independent School District (BISD), in conjunction with Ranger College (RC), or Angelo State University (ASU), offers dual credit for BISD students. By successfully completing these courses, students will receive high school and/or college credit. To receive weighted credit for a RC, or ASU course, a student must be enrolled in the RC, or ASU course and receive a passing grade (70) in the course. All BISD rules and regulations apply to the student enrolled in the RC, or ASU courses, including but not limited to the attendance laws and code of conduct. A dual credit student must be enrolled in BISD high school throughout the RC, or ASU course, or he/she will be dropped from RC, or ASU. BISD students must have a passing score on the TSI or be TSI exempt to enroll in RC, or ASU courses.

BISD dual credit students will be treated as college students by the RC, or ASU faculty. Neither RC, ASU nor BISD will provide progress reports or 6 weeks grades. The college professor will not notify parents or guardians if the student is absent and/or not turning in assignments.
